Leon La Prairie and Peter Telford, Directors of Darnley Bay Resources Limited, and Stephen Reford, Project Manager, attended discussions in Yellowknife, NWT on the 12th to 14th April, 2008. The discussions were in advance of a Paulatuk community meeting on April 26, 2008 concerning ratification and renewal of the Inuvialuit Regional Corporation's Concession Agreement with Darnley Bay Resources Limited.

Attending the discussions in part with Darnley Bay Resources personnel were: Gilbert Thrasher, Sr., Chairman of the Paulatuk Community Corporation and three executive members, Lawrence Ruben, Andy Thrasher and Millie Thrasher; Todd Romaine, Chief Land Administrator of the Inuvialuit Land Administration; Scott Cairns and John Ketchum of the Northwest Territories Geoscience Office; Lou Covello, President of the NWT Chamber of Mines; Don Yamkowy, President of the NWT Chamber of Commerce, and other local business people from Yellowknife.

The discussions centred on Darnley Bay Resources' programme to explore and drill the intrusive source of the gravity/magnetic anomaly underlying the Paulatuk 7(1)(a) lands. As reported by the Geological Survey of Canada, the anomaly has the potential to be a major mineral deposit complex comparable to the Sudbury Basin in Ontario.

The essential purpose of the discussions was to address the necessary requirements under the Inuvialuit Environmental Monitoring program for access to the land. The environmental impact of mineral exploration on wildlife, land and water is a concern, particularly with respect to the caribou and geese. The prospects for procurement of services and employment in Paulatuk were another important consideration.

Responses to the Darnley Bay Resources presentations and proposals in Yellowknife were positive and the Company looks forward to continuing supportive and cooperative relationships with the Inuvialuit communities.
